




- Charge port

### Pair and Charge

#### Get Paired

Be safe! Please read the separate safety guide for important safety information.

Wearing your headset, power it on. The first time you do this it will begin the pairing process. You hear "pairing" and the headset indicator lights flash red and blue.



- 2 Activate Bluetooth<sup>®</sup> on your phone and set it to search for new devices.
  - iPhone Settings > Bluetooth > On\*
  - Android<sup>™</sup> Settings > Bluetooth: On > Scan for devices\* NOTE \*Menus may vary by device.
- 3 Select "PLT\_E50." If necessary, enter four zeros (0000) for the passcode or accept the connection. Once successfully paired, you hear "pairing successful."

#### Activate pair mode

Press the Call button © until the indicator light flashes red and blue and you hear "pairing."

#### Use two phones

Multipoint technology lets you pair a second phone and answer calls on either phone. To pair a second or a new phone see "Activate pair mode."


#### Reconnect

Bluetooth headset has up to a 33 feet (10 meters) effective range. If you lose connection, your headset will try to reconnect. If your headset doesn't reconnect, tap the Call button © or manually connect through the phone's Bluetooth device menu.


#### Charge

Your new headset has enough power to pair and make a few calls. It takes 2 hours to fully charge the headset; the indicator light of turns off once charging is complete.

You can wear your headset on your right or left ear. To adjust the fit, rotate the earloop as shown.



### The Basics



Answer or end a call Tap the Call buttor.

Adjust the volume Tap the Volume button • to cycle through preset levels.

> Mute While on an active call, press and hold the Volume button or 2 seconds. You hear "mute on" or

"mute off."

Redial To call your last number dialed, double tap the Call Button .

Voice dial (phone feature) Press the Call button for 2 seconds, wait for the phone prompt and then tell the phone to dial

the name of a stored contact.

Toggle Voice Prompt When the headset is powered on and you are not on a call the voice prompts can be turned off by On/Off

pushing the volume button and the call button for more than 4 seconds.
